

Flint Bishop Int'l Airport (KFNT) - for FS2004

This is fictional scenery for KFNT, Flint Bishop Int'l Airport, Michigan designed for FS9. I brought this airport up to date because it had been added on to and approaches changed since FS9 was developed.

Bishop International Airport (IATA: FNT, ICAO: KFNT) is a commercial and general aviation airport located in Flint, Michigan. The third busiest airport in Michigan, it surpassed competitor MBS International Airport in terms of airline operations in 2002. The airport is currently served by several passenger airlines: Allegiant Air, Southwest Airlines and Delta Air Lines operate mainline service out of the airport, as well as affiliates of Delta Air Lines, United Airlines and American Airlines. Additionally, FedEx Express operates cargo services out of the airport.

Bishop International Airport covers 1,550 acres (6 km²) and has two runways.

Runway 18/36: 7,848 x 150 ft. (2,392 x 46 m)

Runway 9/27: 7,200 x 150 ft. (2,195 x 46 m)

Runway 5/23 was closed permanently on May 4, 2009

Here is what to look for in this updated file:

- Remove runway 5/23 per current airport diagram.
- Added / edited taxi signs.
- Relocated taxiways that were not properly situated and added missing taxiways.
- Corrected GPS approaches.
- Added missing waypoints and corrected improperly located waypoints.
- Expanded airport property to accommodate additions
- Added some "eye candy".
