

Ft Nelson Airport CYYE for FSX

This is fictional scenery for CYYE, Ft Nelson Airport, B.C. Canada designed for FSX. I created this scenery to make it a bit more realistic. The default scenery was pretty bare and the buildings just didn't fit.

Northern Rockies Regional Airport (Fort Nelson Airport), (IATA: YYE, ICAO: CYYE), is located 3.8 nautical miles (7.0 km; 4.4 mi) east northeast of Fort Nelson, British Columbia, Canada.

The Fort Nelson Airport was also a valuable asset for allied military forces in World War II, as it served as an airbase for the United States Air Force and the Royal Canadian Air Force. Contrary to popular belief that the construction of the Alaska Highway commenced in Dawson Creek, Fort Nelson was the original mile 0 on the Alaska Highway because of the existence of a previously constructed road from Fort Saint John to Fort Nelson.

Here is what to look for in this scenery package:

- Removed most of the default airport buildings and replaced them with more appropriate buildings
- Reconfigured the parking spots and added additional
- Added some taxi signs
- Added night lighting to the ramp area
- Added missing RNAV approaches
- Added missing terminal waypoints for approaches
- Adjusted runway lengths according to latest airport diagram
- Changed the designation of runway 07/25 to 08/26 per latest Airport diagram
- Added landclass to represent the missing town of Ft Nelson
