

Ft Yukon, Alaska Scenery for FS9

This is a representation of Ft Yukon Alaska (PFYU). Fort Yukon Airport covers an area of 261 acres (106 ha) and has one gravel runway (3/21) measuring 5,810 x 150 ft (1,771 x 46 m).

For 12-month period ending December 31, 2005, the airport had 8,350 aircraft operations, an average of 22 per day: 60% air taxi, 37% general aviation and 3% military. There are 13 aircraft based at this airport: 85% single engine and 15% multi-engine.

Here are the changes made to this airport:

- > Removed default buildings and added buildings that look more appropriate for this airport.
- > Reorganized parking.
- > Added ramp area lighting.
- > Added missing taxiway from main ramp to Rwy 4 end.
- > Changed runway designations from 03-21 to 04-22 based on current charts.
- > Added Terminal Waypoints and corrected incorrectly located waypoints according to current approach charts.
- > Modified GPS and RNAV approaches to correspond to current approach charts.
- > Added landclass scenery to represent town of Ft Yukon adjacent to the airport.
- > Added missing roads near airport.
