

Gulkana, Alaska for FSXby: Scenery4FlightSims.com

This is a representation of the Gulkana Airport (PAGK) in Alaska.

Gulkana, Alaska, sits on the east bank of the Gulkana (Kulkana) River at its confluence with the Copper River, 14 miles north of Glennallen. Gulkana is primarily an Alaska Native community (74 percent of the population of about 90), where residents depend somewhat on subsistence hunting, fishing, trapping and gathering.

Here are the changes made:

- > Modified the Gulkana River which was set at incorrect elevation and ended adjacent to the airport.
- > Removed all of the default buildings which were totally unrealistic and replaced with more appropriate buildings.
- > Expanded the ramp area and added additional parking spots.
- > Expanded the airport boundary and changed the background land class.
- > Updated the Runway ID numbers from 14-32 to 15-33.
- > Modified the Approach codes to match the change in runway ID.
- > Extended runway approaches (removed tall trees).
- > Added taxiway signs.
- > Added a dirt taxiway alongside leading to Rwy 15.
- > Added ramp lights for nighttime operations.
- > Added a landclass town south of the airport to represent Glennallen.
