

Medicine Hat Airport, AB (CYXH) for FS-2004

This is fictional scenery for CYXH, Medicine Hat Airport, Alberta, Canada, designed for FS9. I created this scenery to make it a bit more realistic. The default scenery was pretty bare and the buildings just didn't fit.

Medicine Hat Airport, (IATA: YXH, ICAO: CYXH), is located 2 nautical miles (3.7 km; 2.3 mi) southwest of Medicine Hat, Alberta, Canada. Air Canada Express serves the airport daily from Calgary.

During World War II the site was used as part of the British Commonwealth Air Training Plan (BCATP) for No. 34 Service Flying Training School (SFTS). The SFTS was open from 8 April 1941 to 17 November 1944. In 1939, the Department of National Defence appropriated the Medicine Hat Exhibition and Stampede Grounds, which was also used as a Prisoner of War camp.

Here is what to look for in this scenery package:

- Removed most of the default airport buildings and replaced them with more appropriate buildings
- Reconfigured the parking spots and added additional
- Added some taxiways and taxi signs
- Added night lighting to the ramp area
- Made some modifications to the terrain to fix Microsoft errors
