

Northway, Alaska for FSX

This is a representation of Northway Airport Alaska (PAOR). Northway Airport (IATA: ORT, ICAO: PAOR, FAA LID: ORT) is a state owned, public use airport serving Northway, a community located in the Southeast Fairbanks Census Area of the U.S. state of Alaska. During World War II for northbound Lend-Lease aircraft on the Northwest Staging Route, the flight strip at Northway was the first stop in the Territory of Alaska.

Northway Airport covers an area of 1,150 acres (465 ha) at an elevation of 1,715 feet (523 m) above mean sea level. It has one runway designated 5/23 with an asphalt surface measuring 5,100 by 100 feet (1,554 x 30 m).

For the 12-month period ending December 31, 2005, the airport had 15,800 aircraft operations, an average of 43 per day: 73% general aviation, 25% air taxi, and 2% military.

Here are the changes made to this airport:

- > Removed default buildings and added buildings that look more appropriate for this airport.
- > Reorganized parking.
- > Added ramp area lighting.
- > Changed the runway designation from 4-22 to 5-23 according to recent airport information.
- > Lengthened the runway and paved with asphalt based on current airport information.
- > Cleared some trees from the approach to runway 23.
- > Added Terminal Waypoints according to current approach charts.
- > Modified GPS and RNAV approaches to correspond to current approach charts and new runway designation.
- > Added landclass scenery to represent the Village of Northway.
