This is a representation of St Marys Airport (PASM) Alaska.

St. Mary's Airport covers an area of 3,600 acres (1,500 ha) and contains two gravel surfaced runways: 17/35 measuring 6,008 x 150 feet (1,831 x 46 m) and 6/24 measuring 1,520 x 60 feet (463 x 18 m).

Airlines Destinations from PASM served by Era Alaska:

Anchorage, Alakanuk, Aniak, Bethel, Emmonak, Kotlik, Mountain Village, Nunam Iqua/Sheldon Point, Pilot Station.

Airport Modifications:

- > Realigned runway based on current Magnetic Variation.
- > Changed runway designation from 16-34 to 17-35 based on current charts.
- > Removed default buildings and replaced with stock buildings more appropriate for this airport.
- > Add turn-around pads at far ends of runways.
- > Added Landclass town to represent the village of St Marys.
- > Added road connecting village to airport.
- > Added ramp lights.
- > Corrected misplaced waypoints and added missing waypoints for approaches based on current approach charts.
