St. Mary's Airport covers an area of 3,600 acres (1,500 ha) and contains two gravel surfaced runways: 17/35 measuring 6,008 x 150 feet (1,831 x 46 m) and 6/24 measuring 1,520 x 60 feet (463 x 18 m).

Here are the changes made to this airport:

- > Removed default buildings and added buildings that look more appropriate for this airport.
- > Reorganized parking.
- > Added ramp area lighting.
- > Adjusted Lengthen of the runway and realigned based on change in Magnetic Variation & current airport data.
- > Changed runway 16-34 to 17-35 based on current airport data.
- > Added landclass scenery to represent the Village of St Mary's.
- > Added road from airport to village.
- > Added airport "flatten" to correct the disappearing runway 6-24.
