

Williams Lake Airport CYWL for FSX

This is fictional scenery for CYWL, Williams Lake Airport, B.C. Canada designed for FSX. I created this scenery to make it a bit more realistic. The default scenery was pretty bare and the buildings just didn't fit.

Williams Lake, is a city in the Central Interior of British Columbia, Canada. Located in the central part of a region known as the Cariboo, it is the largest urban centre between Kamloops and Prince George, with a population of 10,832 in city limits.

Williams Lake Airport or Williams Lake Regional Airport, (IATA: YWL, ICAO: CYWL), is located 4.2 nautical miles (7.8 km; 4.8 mi) northeast of Williams Lake. The Airport was opened in 1956 by Transport Canada, and on January 1, 1997 the ownership and operations of the airport was transferred from Transport Canada to the City of Williams Lake. The airport operates as an independent department within the City's Municipal Services. The catchment area of the airport is within the City and an area of about 100 km surrounding the City. Along with scheduled commercial flights, the airport services the Cariboo Initial Attack Fire Center, helicopter, aircraft maintenance, medivac, corporate, and general aviation operations.

Here is what to look for in this scenery package:

- Removed most of the default airport buildings and replaced them with more appropriate buildings
- Reconfigured the parking spots and added additional
- Added some taxi signs
- Added night lighting to the ramp area
- Updated VOR and NDB approaches
- Added missing terminal waypoints for approaches
- Added the missing Williams Lake (body of water)
- Added landclass to represent the missing City of Williams Lake
- Added float-plane docks at West end of the lake
